

Rawcliffe Parish Council – Transport Advisory Committee

Objectives:

- To source passenger transport initiatives for consideration by the council
- To work with other interested parties in achieving this objective

Administration:

- All administrative duties shall be undertaken by the clerk to the council.
- The clerk will convene ordinary meetings of the committee and the chairman of this committee will convene extraordinary meetings.
- Minutes of meetings will be ratified by this committee and circulated to all members of Rawcliffe Parish Council for reference.

Remit:

To produce reports for consideration by Rawcliffe Council regarding:

- passenger transport initiatives that benefit those who reside or work in the parish.
- all other matters relevant to the passenger transport provision for the parish

Committee Structure:

The Transport Committee of Rawcliffe Parish Council will consist of the following:

A minimum of 3 members; of which at least two are parish councillors.

Chairman: Elected from and by members of the Transport Committee

Vice-Chairman Elected from and by members Transport Committee

Maximum number of Committee Members is to be determined by the committee as deemed appropriate for the remit

Membership of the committee will be reviewed annually at the annual meeting of the parish council in May.

Procedures:

The committee will follow all the relevant legislation the for convening its meetings as those applied to meetings of the full council, within Local Government Act 1972.

Quorum:

A quorum will be three; one of which will be a parish councillor.
